

SAL & Sai Maritime hit milestone in wind energy

MUMBAI, May 28

SAL Heavy Lift has successfully loaded the longest windmill blade of 72.4 metres from Tuticorin to Germany, exported by Nordex India Pvt. Ltd, highlighted a release.

MV Maria was booked to load the windmill blade and she arrived on time at Tuticorin Port (VOC Port) on May 26, 2020 and berthed on arrival. Loading was completed in 2 hours, and after completion of all lashing/securing, the

vessel sailed on May 27.

This was the longest blade to be loaded out from India, the release said. It is another milestone for SAL Heavy Lift, which regularly transports wind turbine equipment around the world.
